Its production was part of a cooperative agreement with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The overall intent is to improve health outcomes of patients diagnosed with blood clots and clotting disorders.

This curriculum is divided into five lessons:

- 1) Basics of Clotting
- 2) Basics of Thrombophilia
- 3) Anticoagulant Medications
- 4) Post-Thrombotic Syndrome/Pulmonary Hypertension
- 5) Prevention of Venous Thromboembolism (VTE)

The online content is designed to influence delivery of quality care and provide accurate health information on thrombosis and/or thrombophilia. Individual lessons contain key clinical “teachable moments,” reinforced by various learning strategies that include reference charts, images, videos, interactive exercises, and review questions. A post-test follows each lesson.
