



How to set up your Amazon Smile account to support the National Blood Clot Alliance

1. Go to smile.amazon.com and login with your existing Amazon account or create a new one using your preferred email address.
2. Once logged in, scroll down and type 'National Blood Clot Alliance' in the box to pick your own charitable organization and click 'search'.


